Your Tax Dollars at Work

Last week, the North Carolina General Assembly met to pass HB 10, the bill that bundles racist, fear-mongering ICE detention rules with voucher expansion aiming to fund private school education for the wealthiest families in North Carolina. The bill passed in both the Senate and the House [along party lines](#). The truth is, giving away public tax dollars to wealthy families and private schools at the expense of public schools is *not OK with North Carolina voters*. **It's time to come together with your coworkers and neighbors to elect public school champions in our state.**



Here's what you can do.

1. Make a plan to vote. Check out bit.ly/GuilfordEV for Early Voting locations, dates, and times, OR vote on Election Day at your precinct polling location. Remember to bring your ID.

2. Canvass with your coworkers. We are targeting specific voters who support public schools and need to come out to vote in support of our Focus Five candidates: Josh Stein for Governor, Mo Green for State Superintendent, Allison Riggs for NC Supreme Court, Tanneshia Dukes for NC House District 59, and Mary Beth Murphy for County Commission.
