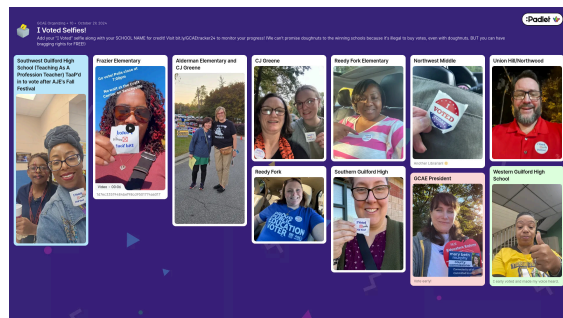
ELECTION DAY IS THIS TUESDAY!
